Safety Leads are Conference employees and/or volunteers who serve as conduits between local church employees and the Susquehanna Conference Safety Committee.

A number of resources are available to assist Safety Leads fulfill the duties of the role and assist your local church steward the health and safety of Church employees and resources.

The Safety Lead section of the Safety Committee website, found here <https://susumc.org/safety-lead/>, contains a plethora of resources. Note this site also allows you to register yourself as your church's Safety Lead. Resources include:

- Link to a recorded webinar, explaining suggested Safety Lead duties;
- Link to a "Safety Lead Binder", a printable PDF (note, if you don't have access to a printer, we can print for you upon request);
- Information on monthly Safety Inspections to keep your church in compliance with government regulations; and more!

Following is a list of suggested Safety Lead duties; resources are found on the Safety Committee website [www.susumc.org/workplace-safety/](http://www.susumc.org/workplace-safety/). We urge you to explore the site!

- Orient new employees to "safety" on the job.
- Know how to report Workers' Compensation (work-related) injuries.
- Deliver monthly safety talks.
- Informally inspect the workplace to look for potentially hazardous conditions, paying special attention to slip, trip, and fall hazards.
- Ensure that "formal" monthly inspections are conducted on three important items: Exit Doors, Emergency Lighting, and Fire Extinguishers.
- Assist with the annual church inspection as required by the Conference (this is a Trustee responsibility).
