- 3 Include a budget if available
- 4 Funds must not be used to pay transportation costs, rent subsidies, electric, telephone, heat, fuel, or facility upgrades
- 5 There is no funding for administrative costs or salaries

**The above items are important for consideration of funding. If you cannot provide all information, please submit the information you have with your application.**

**Grants will be reviewed early in the Spring of 2022.  
Grant awards will be sent in late Spring 2022.**
