



Discipleship Pathways offer opportunities for a deeper learning encounter and growth in your own personal faith experiences. Each pathway class presents a unique study that will bring a fresh understanding of Scripture and our place in the life of the Church. The founder of Methodism, John Wesley once experienced a warming of his heart within as he felt the moving of the Holy Spirit. Perhaps God is calling you to a fresh awakening of the Spirit within you. You are warmly invited to step onto a fresh pathway in your discipleship.

The Church and Conflict

Conflict is normal, neutral, and necessary in any system whether it be family, community, workplace, and yes, church. Unity, love, and truth are signs of Christian maturity (Ephesians 4:13-15). We show our love when we care enough to confront conflict. How can we lovingly resolve conflict as we grow towards unity in Christ? How do we heal our hearts and our relationships? How can we accept confronting conflict as a necessary part of spiritual and emotional growth? We will spend time addressing these questions. We will look at predictable sources of conflict, healthy vs. unhealthy conflict, Biblical principles and practical methods. *No additional texts are needed, instructor will provide any readings needed.*

Keith Braucher is currently serving Stewartstown United Methodist Church. He holds a doctorate in Pastoral Counseling and with over 30 years of counseling experience along with coaching and consulting with congregations including 10 years in 12 congregations as an interim pastor to troubled congregations.

Class will meet on Friday evening Oct. 14, 2022 starting at 6pm until 8:30pm and continue on Saturday Oct 15th at 8am ending at 5pm. (ZOOM class will be at the same time.)
