CARE KIT: ALL NEW ITEMS

- **Hand towel:** Must be good quality. Kitchen, cleaning and microfiber towels are acceptable. Please ensure the towel is dry.
- **Wash cloth:** Adult size. Please ensure wash cloth is dry.
- **Comb** Any size or shape comb, including picks and pocket combs, are acceptable.
- **Metal nail file OR clipper** Please do not remove UPC sticker - this leaves a sticky residue. Toenail clippers are acceptable. No emery boards.
- **Bath size soap** 2.5 oz. and larger. No Ivory, Jergens or Lisa brand soaps.
- **Toothbrush Adult size.** Ensure packaging is completely sealed. Dental ads are okay.
- **Adhesive bandages 6 3/4" to 1" width.** Common household band aids preferred.
- **Plastic bag** 1 One-gallon size, resealable only.
